Torrevieja has 4 main beaches, the most popular beaches Cura and Locos. Again fine sand and all kinds of facilities alongside a beachfront promenade. At the other end to the south you will find the beach of Los Naufragos. If peace and tranquillity is what you are looking for Torrevieja on the Costa Blanca is the place. All set in a beautiful nature setting of esplanades, gardens, parks and beaches. Torrevieja's sandy beaches are among the most popular on the whole coast of Spain



La Mata Beach



La Mata, a 2300 metres long and over 40 metres wide beach, is located at the Torrevieja's district of Torre La Mata. To the south it adjoins the Cape Cervera, and to the north it delimits the area of La Mata Tower, which has given its name to this district.

It has a really long esplanade which runs all along the beach, where you can visit many chiringuitos and restaurants. At the other side of the beach we can find a wide sand dunes.

The beach is sandy and you can walk along it north to Guardamar or south, via the wooden walkway to Torrevieja.

In Alicante the mild climate makes it possible to maintain a beach life for the entire year round. In the area there are both long stretches with golden sand and hideaway small bays as well as naturist beaches. Tourists enjoy the sun and the beach as well as take in part of the culture and entertainment of a cosmopolitan city with its museums, monuments, year round and regular fiestas have made the perfect choice when they visit Alicante on Spain's Costa Blanca. There is plenty to do all year round not just through the summer months.

Santa Pola Beach



Santa Pola, is a small fishing port on the Costa Blanca. It is famous for its variety of landscapes and mountain ranges to sand ranges. La Marina Beach

La Marina, 20 minutes south of Alicante is a small beach resort set in dunes and with some of the longest beaches on the Costa Blanca covering over 17 km. La Marina is a smaller village with varied sports facilities some cafes together with a range of shops and bars. The Town is divided into the old Pueblo between the coast road and the sea, and the new inland urbanisation.
