Guadalest

The mountain village of Guadalest has the population of just over 200 but through the year they get over 2.000.000 visitors from around the world. To get there you drive by Terra Mitica amusement park, take the exit to Benidorm and continue to the mountains. The road to Guadalest has asphalt but twists and turns up the mountain side. To drive up there is a memorable experience. In the village you can visit an old Moorish Fortress from the 7. Century, built on a rock, 900 meters above sea level. In addition you can visit two interesting museums: The Belen Museum of Micro-miniatures and the Museum of Torture.



Torrevieja.

Torrevieja is a busy, bustling town that has a lively atmosphere all year round, day and night. There are over 105,000 inhabitants 55% of which are of foreign origin. Torrevieja includes many residential areas which can be grouped together into nine main zones, all of which are well served by local bars, restaurants and shops as well as being highly residential.

Some of the best beaches can be found close to town, including Los Locos and Playa Del Cura. Along the front of Los Locos beach there are bars and restaurants with more bars throughout the back streets, Also Situated next to the Port car park. Open during the summer season, is the fun fair, great for the kids and kids at heart.



Elche
